

REMINDER: Don't lose the opportunity to provide your input to ENTSOG CBA methodology update!

In order to give stakeholders more time to respond to the consultation on the CBA methodology update ENTSOG has **extended until Friday 23 June 2017** the deadline to provide feedback.

ENTSOG formulated the identified possible paths to update the current CBA methodology taking into consideration the Opinions of ACER on TYNDP 2015 and TYNDP 2017 as well as the recent findings of the study mandated by the EC, whose draft recommendations were released in March 2017. In early 2017, ENTSOG has organised meetings with 'Prime Movers' to identify what are the most expected improvements in the CBA methodology. ENTSOG has taken these proposals into consideration in the identification of the possible improvements and the preparation of this consultation.

To whom is it addressed?

All stakeholders interested in gas infrastructure development and in particular network users, project promoters, associations, and authorities.

The new version of the methodology will be a cornerstone for the preparation of the next editions of TYNDP, PCI list and preparation of Cross-Border Cost Allocation (CBCA) analyses.
