The stakeholder engagement process




The stakeholder engagement process: the first step of the TYNDP development process

- > 5 Stakeholder Joint Working Sessions planned from January to March 2016
- > In parallel, ENTSOG team is available for any bilateral meeting upon participant initiative

The stakeholder engagement process: a key element

- > It will allow to factor the stakeholder contribution in the TYNDP concept, and therefore in the TYNDP assessment
- > The TYNDP concept will be presented in a Public Workshop in April 2016
