

## Speaking Notes

On 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017, **Jan Ingwersen**, ENTSOG General Manager, and **Celine Heidreich**, ENTSOG Business Area Manager, spoke at the ENTSOs joint workshop **“TYNDP 2018 Scenario Report: What we envisage up to 2040”** See below some ENTSOG positions, expressed by both.

CH: For the first time ENTSOs have joined efforts to develop the scenarios, building on combined expertise and on an enlarged stakeholder input from the industry, NGOs, National Regulatory Authorities and Member States.

Jl: The TYNDP presents scenarios which should be used as a “reality check”. In addition to these, “visionary” approaches may be considered – but outside of TYNDP.

CH: The scenarios are complemented by an additional perspective based on the EC EUCO30 policy scenario.

Jl: Each path represents specific challenges and opportunities for the European energy system.

CH: Decarbonisation should be smart, efficient and secure. Developing renewable energy sources and looking for the best possible integration of the electricity, gas and transport systems will be key.

Jl: We see these transparent scenarios as a sound basis for the TYNDP and for any party wishing to perform their own analysis of future policies, market designs or technologies
