ENTSOG publishes supporting documents for the project collection process for the Ten-Year Network Development Plan 2020 (TYNDP 2020)

(Brussels, 23 May 2019, PR0184-19) **ENTSOG published today its Documentation Kit to support project promoters in the process of submitting their projects for the Ten-Year Network Development Plan 2020 (TYNDP 2020), in line with Regulation (EC) 347/2013, Annex III.2 (4). This also represents the first step for the European Commission's 5th selection of Projects of Common Interest (PCI).**

Project promoters should submit their projects for TYNDP 2020 during the 'Project Submission Phase' between **30 May and 28 June 2019**. Project promoters who have already submitted their projects for TYNDP 2018 are required to re-submit their projects and provide up-to-date data to allow their projects to be considered. Submission will be via an [online questionnaire](#) and access credentials can be checked in advance of the commencement date.
