ENTSOG publishes its Annual Report 2018 and Monitoring Reports for CAM Network Code and CMP Guidelines

(Brussels, 12 June 2019, PR0185-19) **ENTSOG publishes its Annual Report 2018 and implementation and effect monitoring reports for CAM Network Code and CMP Guidelines for 2018.**

The Annual Report assesses ENTSOG's work and achievements retrospectively for each given year and provides an opportunity for comparing the delivered results against those outlined in its Annual Work Programme. In parallel, implementation and effect monitoring reports on the Capacity Allocation Mechanism Network Code and Congestion Management Procedure Guidelines have been prepared.

It was a busy year for ENTSOG in terms of investment planning, infrastructure assessment and scenario development (jointly with ENTSO-E) for the EU energy system. The Draft Ten-Year Network Development Plan (TYNDP) 2018 report was published in December and in October, ENTSOG published the adapted version of its 2nd Cost-Benefit Analysis (CBA) Methodology for gas infrastructure projects, which was subsequently approved by the European Commission.

For the second year running, ENTSOG hosted its annual conference, titled 'Gas Infrastructure in a Sustainable Economy' to a wide group of ENTSOG stakeholders, including the European Commission and a range of electricity and gas representatives.

Jan Ingwersen, ENTSOG General Manager, said, "As well as fulfilling its regulatory tasks in 2018, ENTSOG continued its work to highlight gas innovation, decarbonisation and the coupling of gas and electricity systems. As from the end of the year, ENTSOG Members could showcase their many energy transition projects on ENTSOG's new website."
