***The gas and electricity ENTSOs commence
consultation on the draft TYNDP 2020 Scenarios***

(Brussels, 25 November 2019, PR0195-19) **ENTSO-E and ENTSOG announce the commencement of the public consultation on their draft joint Scenario Report for TYNDP 2020. The consultation period starts on 25 November and will continue until 17 January 2020.**

Regulation (EU) 347/2013 requires that the ENTSOs use scenarios for their respective Ten-Year Network Development Plans (TYNDPs). On 12 November, the ENTSOs published their draft joint Scenario Report for TYNDP 2020 – the press release, which includes links to the associated documents, is available on the ENTSOG website, [here](#). The report outlines the three scenarios developed: **‘National Trends’**, **‘Global Ambition’** and **‘Distributed Energy’**.

After consideration of stakeholder feedback, the report will be finalised and the ENTSOs will progress to develop their TYNDPs to continue their assessment of the needs of the European gas and electricity infrastructures.
