### ***ENTSOG issues Final Call to submit Energy Transition Related projects to TYNDP 2020***

(Brussels, 14 May, PR0208-20) **Today, ENTSOG launches the final call for submitting Energy Transition Related projects to ENTSOG's Ten-Year National Development Plan 2020 (TYNDP 2020).**

For the first time, ENTSOG's TYNDP 2020 includes Energy Transition Related projects. These are projects which facilitate the integration of renewables, the achievement of decarbonisation and efficiency targets, reduction of other air pollutants, sector coupling initiatives and, more generally, all projects specifically aimed at the energy system transformation for reaching sustainability goals. Renewable, decarbonised and low carbon gas projects can play a significant role in the European energy transition and ENTSOG is pleased to facilitate the inclusion of these projects in the TYNDP process.

Project promoters can continue to submit Energy Transition Related projects via the ENTSOG Project Portal **until Monday 15 June 2020**. Promoters who have not previously submitted projects to ENTSOG's TYNDP are requested to contact the ENTSOG System Development team ([projects@entsog.eu](mailto:projects@entsog.eu)) for the creation of the Project Portal credentials.

Submitted project information must comply with the administrative and technical criteria set out in the ENTSOG TYNDP 2020 Practical Implementation Document, available on the ENTSOG website, [here](#).

In November 2019, ENTSOG published its TYNDP 2020 draft project list ([link](#)) and is currently working on the finalisation and publication of the draft TYNDP 2020 Report.
