ENTSOG opens public stakeholder consultation on its Annual Work Programme (AWP) 2021

(PR0214-20, Brussels, 5 August 2020) Today, ENTSOG launches a public consultation on its Annual Work Programme 2021. The feedback from stakeholders will contribute to defining the right priorities and identifying the most relevant projects for ENTSOG in 2021.

Jan Ingwersen, ENTSOG General Director, said, "As well as our usual tasks, ENTSOG will work on strategic topics to facilitate gas grids playing a constructive role in the energy transition. This incorporates work on the repurposing, retrofitting and refurbishment of the gas grids for the transport of renewable and low carbon gases, including hydrogen. ENTSOG also recognises the role it plays in the EU's COVID-19 recovery plan, in securing uninterrupted energy delivery."

The consultation starts today (5 August) and will be open until 8 September 2020.
