Registration for 4th edition of ENTSOG and the Florence School of Regulation Gas Network Codes online course ends this week

(Brussels, 8 February, PR0230-21) ENTSOG and Florence School of Regulation (FSR) continues with the 4th edition of the EU gas Networks Codes (NCs) online training this year. Deadline for registration is 11 February 2021.

This course was developed in partnership with FSR and promotes the regulatory knowledge of the gas NCs, to facilitate the understanding of their legislative background, design and implementation.

The course includes interactive learning, recorded interviews with ENTSOG and Transmission System Operators (TSOs), NC experts, group activities and interaction with NC specialists during live classes. To date, almost 250 participants from all over Europe, and further afield from Brazil, Russia and Egypt, have joined the course over the past three editions.
