ENTSOG publishes project collection supporting documents for TYNDP 2022

(11 October, PR0252-21) **Today, ENTSOG published its Documentation Kit to support project promoters in the process of submitting their projects for the Ten-Year Network Development Plan 2022 (TYNDP 2022).**

Project promoters should submit their projects for TYNDP 2022 during the 'Project Submission Phase' between **18 October and 12 November 2021**. Project promoters who have already submitted their projects for TYNDP 2020 are required to re-submit their projects and provide up-to-date data to allow their projects to be considered. Submission will be via an [online questionnaire](#) and access credentials can be checked in advance of the commencement date.
