The Candidate will be **based in Brussels** and should be ready to **start work as soon as possible at the latest in Q3 2023**.

Appointees from ENTSOG Members will be seconded based on a contract between ENTSOG and the seconding TSO, usually for a period of 3 years. Appointees outside the TSOs will negotiate the contract conditions and duration.

- Supporting SPC Director and General Director in ensuring timely delivery on ENTSOG's policy processes;
- Monitoring of regulatory and policy related developments and supporting the development of ENTSOG policy positions, in close cooperation with ENTSOG business areas;
- Stakeholder management, as outlined in ENTSOG stakeholder engagement plan for dedicated process;
- Leading, coordinating and supporting internal working groups, including ENTSOG's own and external groups like Clean Hydrogen Alliance and Future of Gas Grids Panel;
