## ENTSOG opens public stakeholder consultation on its Annual Work Programme (AWP) 2024

(Brussels, 14 July, PR0297-23) **Today, ENTSOG launched a public consultation on its Annual Work Programme 2024** and is inviting stakeholders to contribute in defining the right priorities and to identify the most relevant projects for ENTSOG in 2024.

Piotr Kuś, ENTSOG General Director, said, "The ENTSOG team is prepared to undertake the tasks required within the upcoming regulatory framework of the Hydrogen and Decarbonised Gas Markets package, as it has done so effectively on all its tasks since its foundation in 2009. In the meantime, we plan to address the anticipated topics for 2024 of unbundling, tariffs, financing, guarantees of origin/certificates, gas quality and hydrogen, biomethane and CO<sub>2</sub> transport and handling, cybersecurity, as well as enabling security of supply and regional cooperation."

The consultation starts today (14 July) and will be open until 6 September 2023.
