ABOUT YOUR ROLE AS GAS AND HYDROGEN QUALITY ADVISER

The ENTSOG System Operation Area facilitates the implementation and monitoring of key EU legislation and contributes to further developing the EU legislation in the areas of interoperability and transparency. In your new role, you will contribute to our work within the Interoperability Team of the System Operation Area including the development

and the revision of EU legislation. While feeding into the debate on the technical aspects of the energy transition, you will focus on natural gas, renewable gases, hydrogen and CO₂ quality topics.

You will be reporting to the Interoperability Subject Manager.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

The Candidate will be **based in Brussels** and should be ready to start work **in Q1 of 2026**.

Candidates from ENTSOG Members will be preferred and will be seconded based on a contract between ENTSOG and the seconding TSO, usually for a period of 3 years.

SOME OF THE KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF THIS ADVISER ROLE INCLUDE:

- Supporting the members for the implementation of natural gas, renewable gases, H₂ and CO₂ quality requirements;
- ▲ Managing ENTSOG's internal expert groups;
- Cooperating with external stakeholders and experts on quality related topics;
- Cooperating with different organisations and institutions such as Marcogaz, EASEE-gas, CEN, European Commission, ACER on relevant issues;
- → Participate in Working Groups meetings in European associations dealing with Gas Quality to represent ENTSOG's view;
- Organising and leading, internal and external workshops, with the members and stakeholders;
- ▲ Developing and maintaining Business Requirements;
- ✓ Developing positions in relation quality requirements for the future integrated energy grids.

CANDIDATES SHOULD HAVE:

- Technical background, preferably a degree in engineering or equivalent by experience;
- Relevant working experience of at least 3 years;
- ▲ Ability to work with and manage multinational groups;
- ▲ Ability to communicate complex technical topics in a clear and accessible way to non-expert audiences
- ▲ An understanding of the potential future gas market and technical developments that may be needed to improve the current market and to meet future requirements;
- ▲ An open-minded and flexible approach, able to find compromises and results reflecting viewpoints of stakeholders;
- ▲ Ability to manage multiple projects and establish priorities;
- A good understanding of the technical and regulatory and eventually also commercial aspects of gas quality, network operations, renewable gases, especially hydrogen, and the climate change debate;
- ✓ Very good writing and presentation skills in English.
