### ***ENTSOG publishes its Annual Report 2025***

(Brussels, 27 April, PR0367-26) **Today, ENTSOG publishes its Annual Report 2025, which provides a retrospective of ENTSOG’s work and deliverables for the previous year and explains the activities carried out under ENTSOG’s Annual Work Programme.**

The 2025 Annual Report reflects a year marked by heightened geopolitical uncertainty, regulatory change and ambitions to accelerate energy system integration. Security of gas supply assessment, system flexibility analysis and the consideration of integration of renewable and low-carbon gases remained central to ENTSOG’s work, alongside strengthened cooperation with EU institutions, stakeholders and relevant energy organisations.

Throughout 2025, ENTSOG played a key role in coordinating gas system operations following the full cessation of Russian gas transit via Ukraine, supporting TSOs and Member States through the Regional Coordination System for Gas (ReCo System). Despite significant supply shifts, the European gas system demonstrated resilience and flexibility, underpinned by LNG supply, infrastructure adaptations and enhanced cross-border coordination.

The Annual Report also highlights ENTSOG’s engagement into consultation processes of the EU Grids Package, the CO<sub>2</sub> Markets and Infrastructure initiative and the EU Energy Security Framework. In early 2025, ENTSOG also published its position paper *“Decarbonising European Industry: Enhancing Competitiveness, Ensuring Affordable Energy Prices”*, providing recommendations to support Europe’s Clean Industrial Deal and energy transition.

In 2025 ENTSOG progressed on the TYNDP 2026 Scenarios, jointly with ENTSO-E, under the TEN-E framework, strengthening integrated gas, electricity and hydrogen modelling and supporting transparency through extensive stakeholder consultations.

Piotr Kuś, ENTSOG General Director, commented, *“The Annual Report 2025 shows how ENTSOG delivered tangible and practical support for security of supply, resilience and energy system integration during a year of significant change. As the political approval of EU Grids Package approaches, the work carried out in 2025 provides a strong technical basis for more integrated gas, hydrogen and electricity infrastructure planning across Europe.”*
