Winter Supply Outlook ₁



ACER comments for WSO 2011/12>2012/13:

- To be submitted to the ACER in compliance with Art. 9(2) of Reg. 715/2009 
- Publication timing – early perspective: 14.Dec. >8. Nov. 
- Analyse system adequacy under different climatic scenarios: 2-week HDD period 
- Greater attention to supply trends, more detailed analysis of supply variations, incl. lessons learned (supply constraints, disruptions) 

Winter Supply Outlook ₂

- Complementing WSO by supply flow pattern analysis of historical, current and anticipated supply modulations, including daily dynamics, identifying trends and consequences (e.g. shift of gas transit via Ukraine to the Nord Stream) ✍
- Providing ways, means and recommendations to meet demand ✍

Winter Supply Outlook ₂

- Involving stakeholders (shippers, market participants) in the development of WSO, requesting specific info 
- Without prejudice to ACER formal opinion on WSO 2012/13 

Comments re. TYNDP 2013-22

We propose that first/draft final report of ENTSOG in Feb. is not necessarily to be the same as the final one in June 2013

ENTSOG could integrate proposed amendments/comments of consultation process that relate e.g. to the:

- comments of results
- following conclusions
- other less time/resources demanding issues

Assessment of the implementation of the previous TYNDP 2011-20

- identify delays, inconsistencies, barriers, constraints
- provide recommendations, propose measures
