


From Madrid Forum 2007...

- > A gte+ initiative

 to gte+ and then ENTSOG

 gas-roads...
- > started 2008 on voluntary basis to upgraded gas-roads...
- > launched 1st Oct 2013
- > obligatory participation for all TSOs
- > guidelines prescribed detailed data
- > ENTSOG huge effort to support its members' participation




ENTSOG has always been a promoter of transparency



What was the scope of the project?

The new platform is based on a common professional database, used for all ENTSOG/TSOs data needs




Single point of truth for every data in the system; specific needs answered by specific satellites accessing the same data source

What is behind the new TP?



- Data Warehouse and Business Intelligence System: Central data repository, imports the data from multiple data sources, archives the data, ensures consistency, produces analyses and report tools.
- New Transparency Platform: System connected to the DW/BI; web-based, map-based graphical interface, open to general public, pulls the data from the DW/BI

New Transparency Platform

- > Why are we updating the TP now?
 - Achieve consistency in all ENTSOG data
 - Respond to current needs of TSOs and users
- > What are the challenges?
 - We have to meet current and (as far as possible) future transparency needs
- > What are the risks?
 - New requirements not yet well-defined (codes / guidelines / REMIT)
- > What are the opportunities?
 - IT developments on tools and data handling
 - Wider ENTSOG needs can be covered
- > Why are we organizing the WS?
 - To inform
 - To initiate feedback process

What is the complexity



Transparency issues

- TP is based on data provided by the TSOs
- TP has to bring forward meaningful information to all kind of users
- Benefits from data provision have to outweigh costs
- Basic questions:
 - Frequency of updating
 - Granularity
 - Level of detail



Data availability should be beneficial for all
