- > Projects will have to be submitted to ENTSOG Project Portal
 - Press Release announcing call for projects => mid-March
 - Publication of project submission Documentation Kit => mid-March
 - Submission of projects => 11 April to 8 May
 - Cross-check phase by related promoters
 => 9 May to 25 May
- > Gate closure will be applied strictly to ensure timely delivery of TYNDP

Project submission



Following projects can be submitted to TYNDP

- > Transmission projects of cross-border significance
- > LNG regasification terminals
- > UGS projects

Project Portal Documentation Kit: publication mid-March

- > Promoter Handbook: everything promoters need to know, including important recommendations, User Manual, Responsability of project promoter
- > ENTSOG Validation Procedures document
- > ENTSOG Monitoring Activities document
- > Glossary
- > Request Forms (Promoter Creation, Point Creation...)

Promoters: get started!

- > Carefully read the Documentation Kit
- > Webinar will be planned before opening of Call for Projects (end March/beginning April)
- > Get in touch with ENTSOG

Project submission



Additional information will be requested from promoters, including...

> Project cost information

- Individual project cost information will be requested
 - o It will be treated confidentially. It will not be accessible, even to ENTSOG staff
 - Costs will only be provided at aggregated level within the TYNDP. Individual project costs will not be identifiable
- > Self-assessment of investment needs covered by the project
 - To be completed based on information such as needs identified in TYNDP 2015, PS-CBA 2015
- > Precise project schedule
- > Information on inclusion in National Plan
 - Promoter will have to specify whether the project was already submitted to an NDP
 - If not, the promoter will be asked for the reason for not submitting to an NDP

Project submission



Coordination between promoters of related projects is essential

- > Coordination is promoters' responsibility: to start well ahead of submission to TYNDP
- > Project Portal improvements will ease **cross-check of submissions** related to a given interconnection point. Specific reports have been developed:
 - ENR ENTSOG Network Model Report
 - OTR Operator Topology Report
 - CblR / CalR Capacities before / after Lesser of Rule Reports
 - Explanations provided in the Handbook

Legal notice

- > It clarifies promoters and ENTSOG responsibilities in submission
- > For each project, the promoter will have to agree on the legal notice to submit the project

Projects submitted in previous calls will have to be updated





A high level of transparency





ENTSOG will ensure transparency on projects submitted to TYNDP at an early stage

- > A **dedicated SJWS** will be organised (currently planned for **July**) to present projects
- > All non-confidential project information will be made public at this stage (Annex A)





Better consideration of maturity

ACER views presented in SJWS#3



Use specific terminology: e.g. « advanced non-FID projects »

Target of ~50 « advanced non-FID projects »

Proposal 1

- > FEED started OR permitting started
- > AND commissioning within 7 years (from the year of application to the TYNDP)

Proposal 2

- Market testing done OR permitting started
- > AND FEED started
- > AND commissioning within 5 years for transmission projects (different for UGS? LNG?)





ENTSOG welcomes the « advanced non-FID projects » terminology

> To be based on an « advanced status criterion »

ENTSOG welcomes ACER Proposal 1 with a slight improvement

- > Proposal 1 applied to TYNDP 2015 would have led to ~50 projects
- > Slight improvement: projects already selected for <u>CEF grants for FEED</u> to be considered « advanced »

Detailed proposal



Determination of « advanced non-FID project » status

> will be based on project data submitted to the Project Portal

« Advanced status » criterion

> **OR**

FEED started => FEED starting date =< 01/04/2016</p>

OR selected for CEF grants for FEED => Selection date for <u>CEF for grants for FEED</u> to

be declared as FEED starting date

Permitting started => Permitting starting date =< 01/04/2016</p>

AND commissioning within 7 years => Commission date =< 31/12/2022</p>

« Advanced status » application

> The status will apply project by project


TYNDP Infrastructure Level



4 Infra Levels

Infrastructure gap

- > "Advanced status" used to define a 4th one: Advanced Infra Level
 - Only advanced project; lesser-of-rule on status applies to interconnected projects



The TYNDP assesses if, as a whole, the projects belonging to each Infrastructure Level close the Infrastructure gap





Following the release of TYNDP

TYNDP will support the 3rd PCI selection



An improved identification of the infrastructure gap

> re-structuration of the assessement will provide a clear picture of the infrastructure gap along the TEN-E criteria

A better consideration of projects' maturity

> TYNDP will distinguish between FID, advanced, and less advanced projects


An improved TYNDP basis for Project-Specific CBA

- > TYNDP is the basis for the project specific assessment (PS-CBA) of PCI candidates
- > The Advanced Infrastructure Level will improve the TYNDP basis for PS-CBA

Infra Levels in Project-Specific CBA



TYNDP Infra Levels set the basis for Project-Specific CBA







PS-CBA are to take place following the release of TYNDP

ENTSOG is ready to handle PS-CBA modelling of PCI candidates

- > upon invitation from the European Commission...
- > ...and under mandates from promoters
- > PS-CBA modelling would take place in the first months of 2017
