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Context

All NCs/GLs voted

- majority entered into force / are applicable



Timely and correct implementation is priority for EC



Close monitoring and active involvement of EC, ACER, ENTSOs and all stakeholders needed as well as the enforcement of NRAs

Establishment of NC Implementation and Monitoring Group for high-level coordination between ACER, ENTSOs and EC (successor of the previous Planning Group)

Stakeholder involvement to be maintained / further enhanced

Specific roles of the parties

The main parties have different obligations, roles and responsibilities for implementation and for implementation monitoring

- Obligations, roles and responsibilities are defined for the national, regional and EU levels (3rd Package and NCs/GLs)
- At national level:
 - The NCs/GLs place rights, responsibilities and obligations on Member States (Ministries), NRAs and TSOs
 - NRAs are in charge of enforcement of obligations on market operators deriving from NCs and GLs when undertaking their market operations

ACER	 Key role in coordinating implementation by NRAs Providing implementation support, esp. via decisions on terms and conditions, methodologies (GLs) 	 Regular monitoring reports on NCs/GLs implementation, including effect monitoring Regular internal market monitoring identifying barriers
EC	Follow and support the work on implementationEnforcement	Compliance checkOverall IEM progress reports

- Involvement in Florence and Madrid regulatory Fora
- Involvement in electricity Stakeholder Committees
- Workshops, incl. dedicated to NCs/GLs and specific MS/regions
- Trainings (e.g. Florence School of Regulation)
- Comprehensive information on NCs/GLs on ENTSOs' websites



Proposal for a way forward

Establishment of Implementation and Monitoring Group

 High-level coordination of NC/GL implementation (transforming the previous Planning Group of ACER, ENTSOs and EC)

Coordinated implementation guidance

- ACER, ENTSOs and EC to continue providing guidance through existing channels
- Coordinated implementation guidance: questions raised to be channeled and answered in a coordinated manner between ACER, ENTSOs, EC (e.g. via FUNC platform)
- •Transparency and follow-up of guidance in relevant fora (incl. FF, MF, Stakeholder Committees)
