What input have we received and what have we done with it?



### **ENTSOG Transparency Workshop 2016**

- > 1st session: The Transparency platform
  - Most recommendations on functionality level are implemented
    - CAM+CMP relevance at IP Side level and booking platforms added
    - Increased visibility for pipe-in-pipe setups and unlimited interruptible capacity
  - In some cases different interpretations of the regulation
- > 2<sup>nd</sup> session: REMIT Implementation
  - Consultation on REMIT electronic format is launched and ENTSOG will respond
- > 3<sup>rd</sup> session: Tariff NC and transparency requirements
  - ENTSOG's Tariff Data Publication taskforce was established
  - The taskforce has worked very hard to be ready for the deadline for publication of tariffs in early December 2017
  - The TSOs have prepared for the voluntary early implementation in December 2017

The main action point for the TSOs is the continued focus on data quality and data completeness



### TP Satisfaction Survey Q1 2017

- 16 responses in total, 8 TSOs
- No general conclusion made due to limited responses
- Suggestions discussed
  - Some requests are already available on TP
    - Dedicated section with favourites → requires user log-in
    - List of all points → Export Wizard
  - Some requests are too expensive or far-reaching (examples)
    - Multi-language support
    - Gas consumption statistics daily, monthly and yearly max per zone
    - Stretching ENTSOG mandate to make it a one-stop-shop of European gas for market participants
    - Possibility to change unit in the user interface

So what have we done?



### TP Satisfaction Survey Q1 2017

- Some requests are under development
- Calendar section does not always show the affected point's name
- Rename interruptions indicators Q1 2018
- Improve CMP section "Unavailable firm capacity" Q1 2018
- Improved data quality completeness and correctness ongoing

Few tangible suggestions and actions except data quality and completeness



### TP Satisfaction Survey Q3 2017

- 17 responses in total, 8 TSOs
- No general conclusion made due to limited responses
- Suggestions from responders
  - "more flexibility regarding zoom (MAP) and calendar"
  - "For some IPs data about nominations and actual flows do not match."
  - "Request for intense work with NRA and TSO to provide accurate data"
  - "Higher performance in export tool "
  - "Request to see data flow (Map)"
  - "Creating personalised views (TP data section)"

Due to focus on tariffs project, the suggestions have not been discussed and prioritised yet

# How has ENTSOG and TSOs responded?

### TP Satisfaction Survey Q3 2017

- Suggestions from responders
- "Planned interruption of firm services... does not seem to be available for all TSOs."
- "Maintenance data which is published on TSOs' individual websites is not always replicated on the ENTSOG TP (data completeness)"
- "Nordpool has a really nice UMM overview where you can choose a graph to display the impact of a transmission interrupt/capacity across borders (latest interruption)"
- Reasons for choosing other platforms
- "faster data publication "
- "availability of cumulative data, availability of consumption and production data for those countries, which do not report to ENTSOG yet "
- "I check the TSO websites if I don't trust the entsog data."

Due to focus on tariffs project, the suggestions have not been discussed and prioritised yet





### **2<sup>nd</sup> Tariff NC Implementation Workshop**

- Stakeholders are welcoming the standardised table and the early publication
- Stakeholders are expecting APIs for tariffs: ENTSOG will deliver this in Q1 2018
- National issues with approval of certain tariff elements: ENTSOG encouraged TSOs and NRAs to work closely together

Only action point from the workshops is the API delivery

# **How has ENTSOG and TSOs responded?**

### 'Submit a question' form

- Launched December 2016
- Roughly 3-5 questions per week
- General questions answered by ENTSOG
- Specific questions by TSO(s)
- ~250 questions received, most regarding the published data
- TP Functionalities: Approximately 15 %
- TP Data: Approximately 85 %
- Most senders are students, academics and consultants

Of the ~250 questions received, most are regarding the published data

# Feedback from the Madrid forum



### 30th Madrid forum


- Impressive what has been delivered beyond the regulation already
- EC agrees that cost (for additional publication requirements) needs to be discussed
- ACER requests more data validation on ENTSOG's side as data is not always correct/complete
- Stakeholders request quickest possible data publication → no additional data validation
- Stakeholder suggests that the market would function better if data is published on a more frequent basis
- Some stakeholders expressed that they have other views of legal interpretation
- EC: Thank you for your work you have already done so much more than you had to.


ENTSOG and TSOs will continue focus on data quality and completeness

- TP is widely used
- Stakeholders active in sending questions and suggestions
- Lots have been done beyond regulation
- TSOs and ENTSOG continues to focus on data quality and completeness




- > Latest interruptions



### **Projects - UMM implementation**

- > Additional project elements: Completion of 2017 project
  - Automation of REMIT Urgent Market Messages
  - Implementation of the RSS interface required by ACER

### **Projects - Tariff Publication**

> Completion of 2017 Project (e.g. implementing APIs for Tariff Section)

### **Cyber-Security Implementation**

- > Update the IT landscape to ensure a proper IT security.
- Deliver IT requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which comes into force in May 2018





### Suggestions that may require IT projects:

- > On-going improvements and resilience:
  - Review of TP application and planning
  - Business continuity and planning

### What your's view?

- > Improvements to existing sections e.g. CMP
- > 5 years data retention reached on 01/10/2018

# How to publish Tariffs as an NRA?



### ENTSOG has developed a tool which is

- > Easy to access
- > Easy to use
- > Provides validation logic to validate the tariff data before population and ensure completeness
- > Requires little support or maintenance from ENTSOG
- > Export functionality for review before publication
- > Easy publication on the TP
- > The tool generates xml messages for the tariff publication
- > No additional IT projects needed
