
The European Network of Transmission System Operators for Gas (ENTSOG) is performing a Cost-Benefit Analysis study for the selection of a Data Exchange Solution, based on the criteria defined in the Framework Guidelines issued by ACER on July 26th 2012. The draft Cost-Benefit Analysis is based on Stakeholders' feedback received during the SJWSs (Stakeholders Joint Working Sessions) of November 28<sup>th</sup> 2012 and December 11<sup>th</sup> 2012; answers received on the Data Exchange questionnaire during the period of March 21<sup>st</sup> till April 26<sup>th</sup> 2013 and the outcome of the Data Exchange Workshop of April 23<sup>th</sup> 2013.
