European Network of Transmission System Operators for Gas (ENTSOG) publishes an addendum to the Annex A of the Ten Year Network Development Plan 2015. This publication is a follow-up to the exceptional call for projects launched in April at European Commission request.

(Brussels, PR0090-15) Today the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Gas (ENTSOG) publishes an addendum to the Annex A, which lists the projects included in the 2015 edition of the Ten Year Network Development Plan (TYNDP 2015).

The European Network of Transmission System Operators for Gas was asked by the European Commission (see <u>link</u>) to re-open the TYNDP 2015 only to projects in South East Europe that would mitigate the withdrawal of South Stream. ENTSOG subsequently launched an exceptional public call for gas infrastructure projects from 1 to 22 April 2015.

The addendum to the Annex A of the TYNDP 2015 published today by ENTSOG consists of a description of the new or updated submitted projects. The main report has not been updated following European Commission request not to delay the publication of TYNDP 2015 and the selection process of Project of Common Interest.

The projects listed in the addendum fulfil the eligibility criteria of being part of TYNDP 2015 to apply for the label 'Project of Common Interest'.
