Harmonised energy system-wide cost-benefit analysis

Indicators as referred to in Annex IV

- Market integration, contribution to 10% indicator, impact on GTC, price convergence etc.
- RES transmission, sustainability
- Security of supply

In line with principles in Annex V

- Data and scenarios for +5/10/15/20 years
- Costs (CAPEX, OPEX etc.)
- Identify area for the analysis
- Breakdown of benefits per impacted MS



The preliminary Commission opinion...

... Acknowledges:

- The timely publication and submission of the CBA metholdogies
- Adequate and extensive stakeholder consultations

...Takes into account

- improvements made to them since their publication
- ... Expects continuous improvement with every TYNDP
- ... Focuses on making the methodology apt for the next PCI identification exercise and its application in the TYNDP



Further adaptations to the gas CBA methodology are required

- Better integrate the Energy system-wide and project specific
 - Encourages ENTSOG to perform as much of the project specific analysis as possible
- Better describe how to interpret the outputs of the methology
 - Layered aproach of outputs (monetization quantitative indicators qualitative assessment) is acceptable
 - More guidance on project interactions: Complementarity / competition between projects
- Proposed project definition ("mirror" projects) is acceptable
 - Recommends ENTSOG to perform a first filter as part of the TYNDP data collection process




Further adaptations to the gas CBA methodology are required (cont'd)

- Allow measuring cross-border impact of internal projects
- Identify region of impact through the use of modelling
- Allow for all benefits to be calculated by Member State
 - Per project
 - No need to calculate by benefitting sectors (consumer, producer, etc)
 - Consider 3rd countries carefully (EEA other)
 - Important for cross-border cost alloaction
- Capture environmental aspects
- Further develop indicators under the sustainability criterion




Process to identify projects of common interest

The work in the Regional groups starts in September


- Agree on the evaluation approach (by January 2015)
- Project evaluation itself can start after TYNDP is published (gas: end of February)
 - Check eligibility of submitted projects (significant impact, at least 2 MS)
 - Identify clusters and ask ENTSOG for cluster level modelling (March 2015)
- Inputs for the Regional Groups for the project assessment:
 - List of PCI applicants (by November 2014)
 - CBA results: economic performance indicators, monetized benefits, quantitative indicators and qualitative assessments (by end February 2015)
 - Annual implementation report of the current PCIs (? March 2015)
 - Stakeholder consultation results
